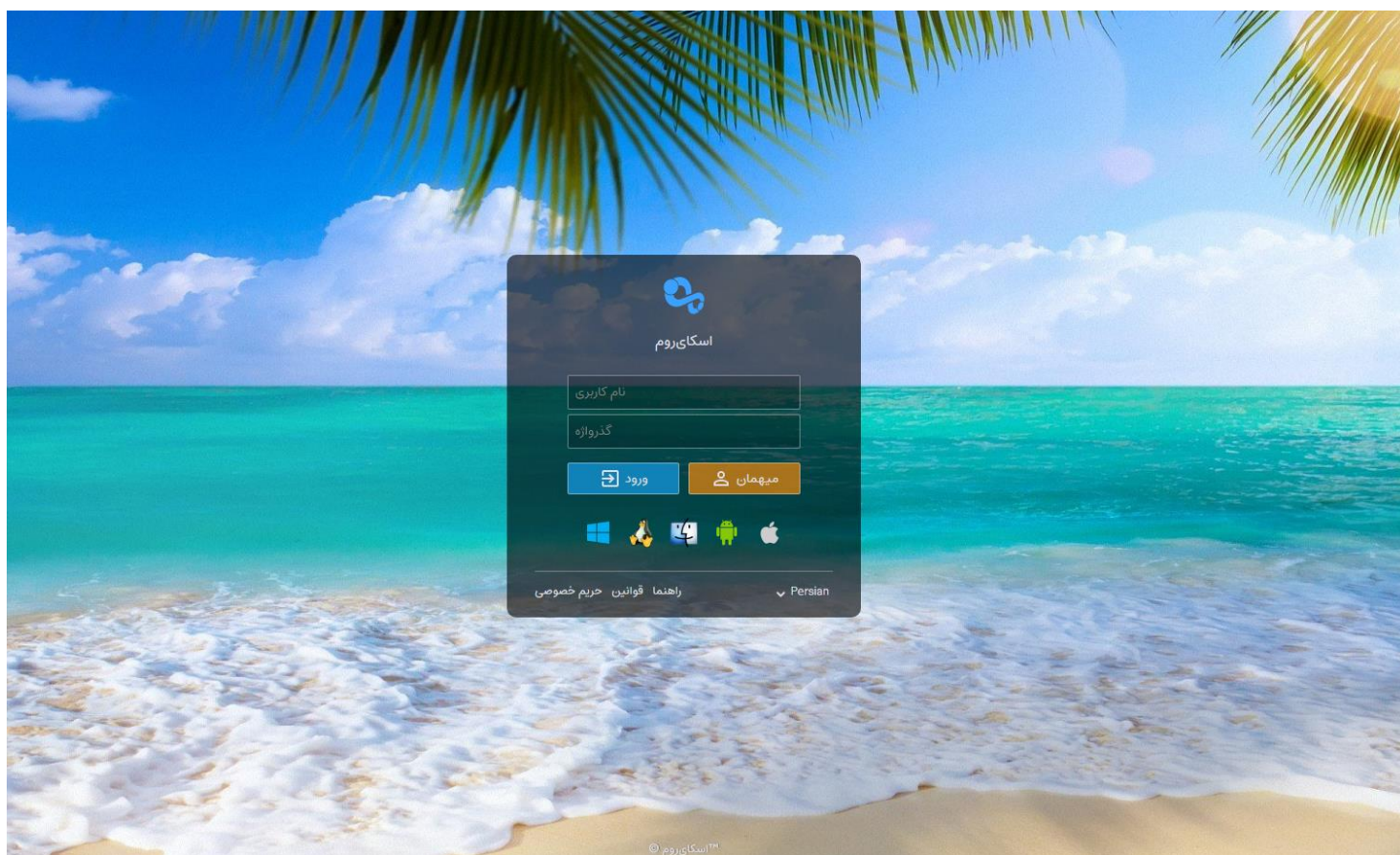

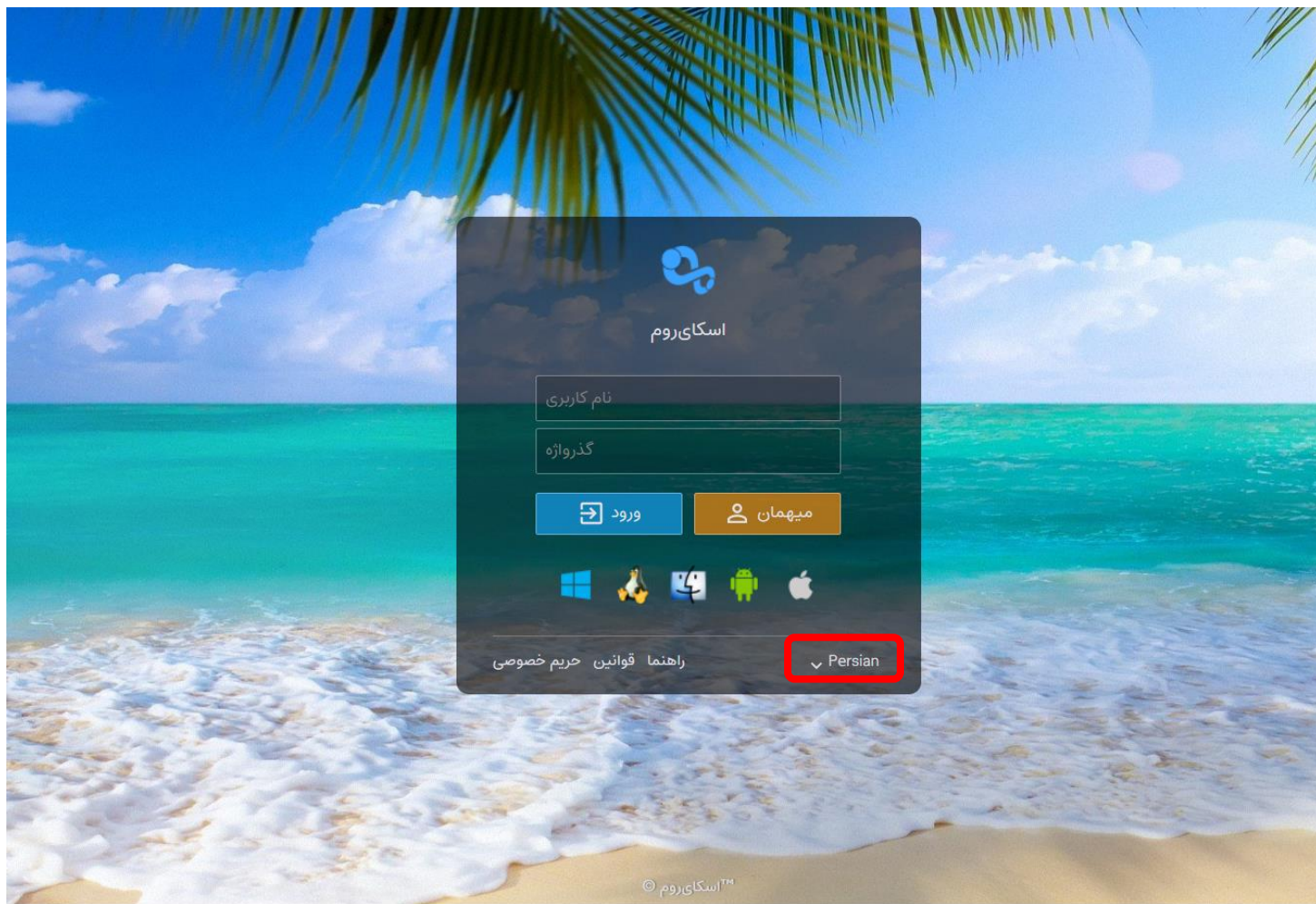

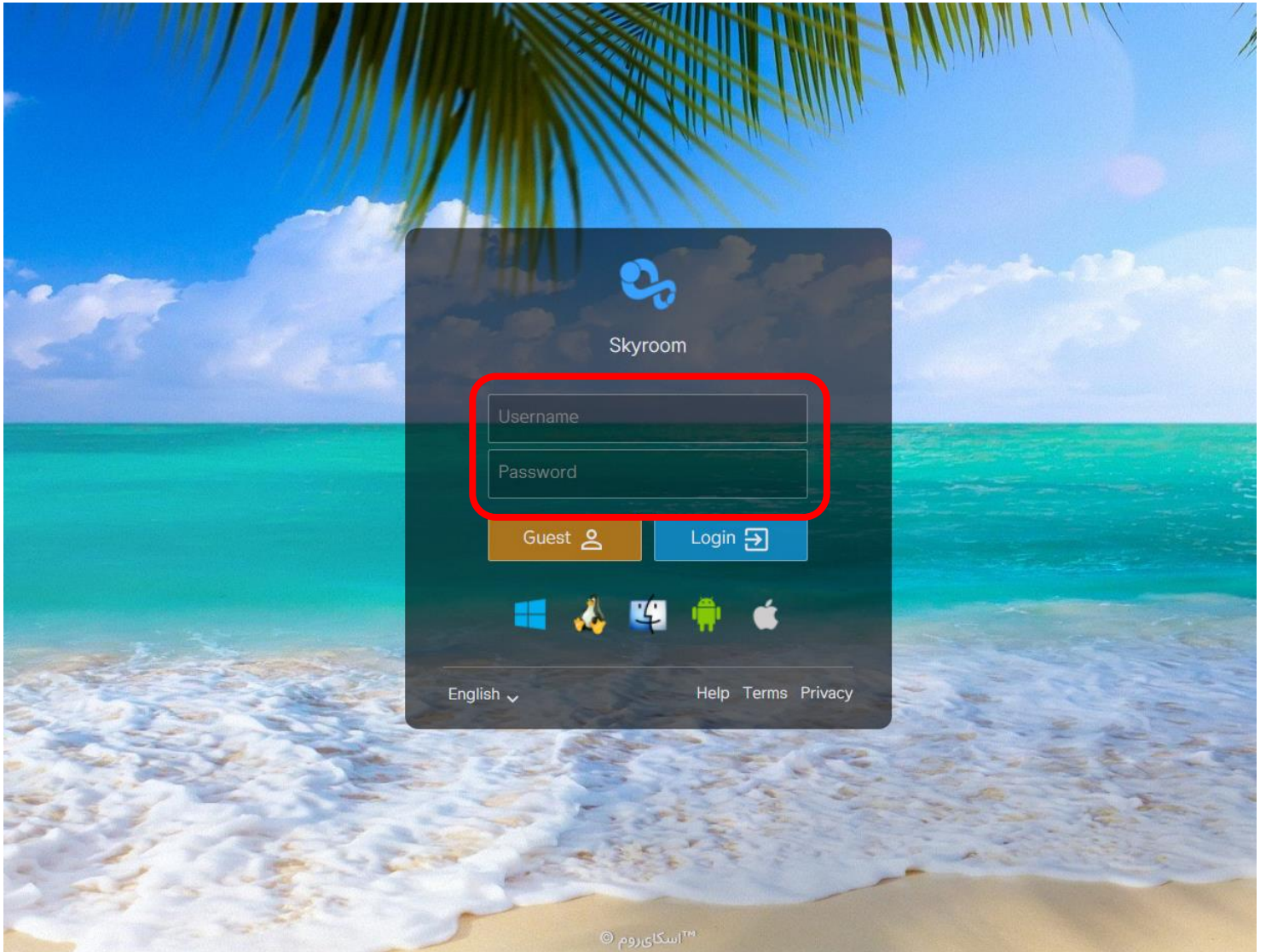
STEP 2

Choose language (English or Persian)



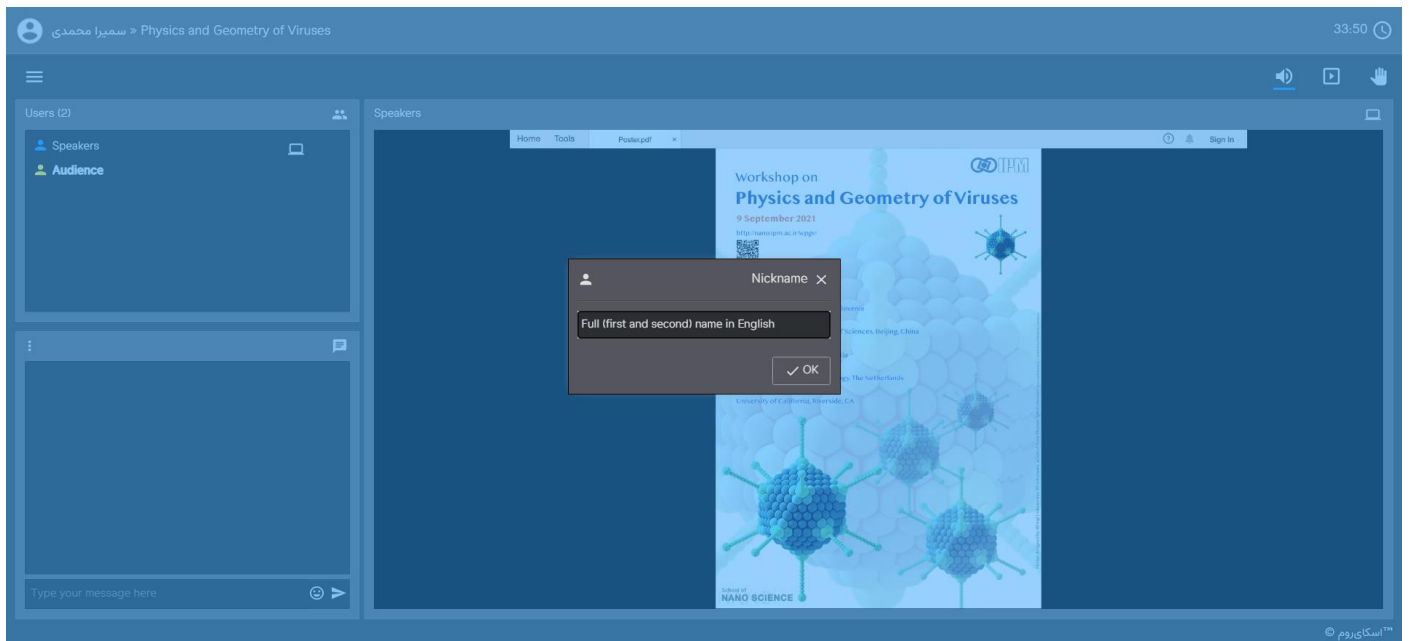
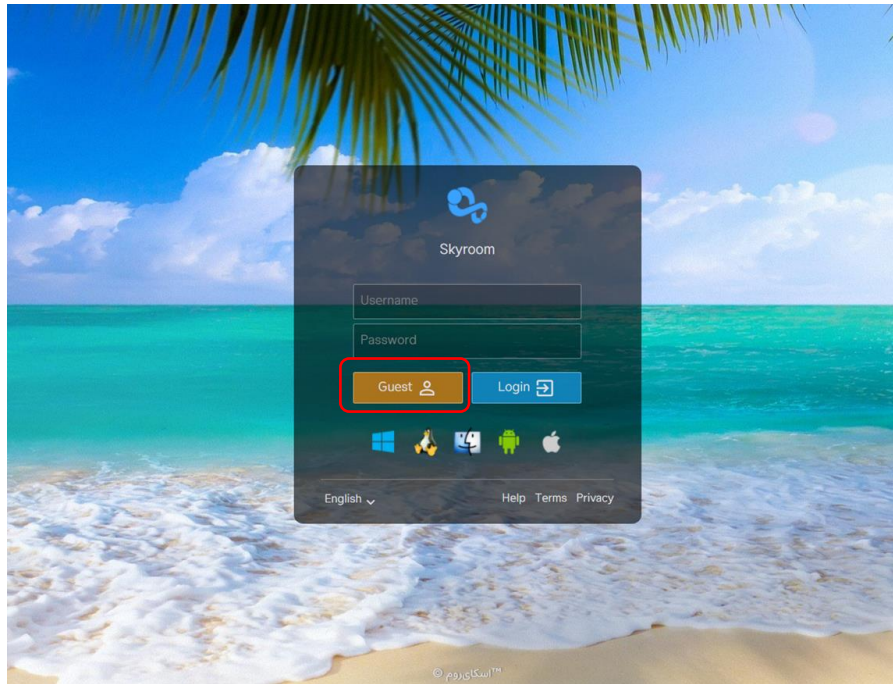
STEP 3 (Speakers & Session Chairs)
